


Item	Description	Qty
1	Grab rail, left hand	1
2	Grab rail, right hand	1
3	Backrest plate	1
4	Backrest pad	1
5	Fixing, M8 x 25 mm (button head)	4
6	Fixing, M8 x 40 mm (socket head thread lock)	2

1 Remove the left hand grab rail fixings (1 & 2). Retain the front fixing (1) for reuse, but discard the rear fixing (2). Retain the grab rail (3) for reuse if the accessory backrest kit is removed.


Repeat for the right hand grab rail.



6mm Bi-hexagonal socket with ratchet



2 Ensure the passenger seat mountings (1) are correctly aligned with the subframe on both side of the motorcycle before starting the backrest kit installation. Right hand side shown.




3 Position the left hand grab rail (1) from the kit on to the passenger seat mountings. Fit one of the original fixings (2) to the front fixing position and a new M8 x 40mm cap head fixing (3) from the kit to the rear fixing position.

Tighten the fixings to 25 Nm.


Repeat for the right hand grab rail.



6mm Bi-hexagonal socket with torque wrench



4 Position the backrest pad (1) on to the left hand (2) and right hand (3) grab rails with the backrest pad towards the front of the motorcycle and aligned with the four grab rail mounting bosses (4), as shown.




5 Position the backrest backplate (1) on to the rear of the backrest pad (2) aligning the four fixing positions. Loosely fit the four M8 x 25mm button head fixings (3) from the kit.

6 Ensure the backrest pad (1) is aligned centrally on the motorcycle.

7 Tighten the four backrest pad fixings (3) to 12 Nm.
